MINUTES:

Motion to approve minutes from June 16, 2020 meeting was made by Caldwell, seconded by Compton, approved 6-0

TRANSFERS & ADDITIONALS:

At this time, a motion was made to approve all transfers by Sanders, seconded by Caldwell, approved 6-0

PUBLIC SAFETY:

Request to transfer \$10,000.00 from 1170-24400-0005 (Officer Supplies) to 1170-38700-0000 (Ambulance)

SHERIFF / E-911:

Request to transfer \$52,000.00 from 1222-41100-0000 (Equipment) to 1222-31102-0000 (Contractual Services)

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS:

GAL/COURTS:

Request for an additional appropriation in fund 1211-31102-0000 (Gal-State Funds) in the amount of \$6,372.00. Motion to approve was made by Claxton, seconded by Sanders, approved 6-0

MISCELLANEOUS:

INNKEEPERS/UPDATE:

Racheal Ackley presented to the Council a packet that included all the different brochures about what Innkeepers is involved in. She advised a lot of events for 2020 have been canceled and will not take place. Probation – request to replace a part-time position, that left employment, motion to approve was made by Claxton, seconded by Compton, approved 6-0

Sheriff – request to replace 1 Merit Officer that is retiring and 2 jail officers, motion to approve was made by Caldwell, seconded by Compton, approved 6-0

Auditor – request to replace 1 part-time employee, motion to approve was made by Smith, seconded by Claxton, approved 6-0

RECORDER/ PERPETUATION ORDINANCE:

The County Recorder presented the Council with her year Ordinance, stating what can be spent out of the Recorder's Perpetuation Fund for the 2021 Budget, this amount is \$119,050.00, motion to approve Ordinance 2020-13 was made by Sanders, seconded by Compton, approved 6-0
