**MISCELLANEOUS:**

**COUNCIL / RESOLUTION TRANSFER OF FUNDS:**

The County Auditor presented the County Council with Resolution 2025-08 allowing the Auditor to transfer money from the RACINO account to miscellaneous accounts that are in the negative from departments overspending. Total amount to come out of the RACINO Fund is \$174,632.74. The Auditor explained the biggest on is the Fuel Center. The Council started the Fuel Center with money to fill the tanks and the expenses keep coming in before the departments get their monthly claims paid. We will be transferring \$100,000.00 for the Fuel Center to help keep it in the positive. Motion to approve Resolution 2025-08 was made by Merrick, seconded by Langkabel, approved 6-0.

## **HUMAN RESOURCES:**

### **REQUEST TO POST 2 VACANCIES:**

1. Youth Assistance Program: This is a replacement for a Part-time Receptionist with a rate of \$19.89 to \$21.80 a hour. Motion to approve was made by Langkabel, seconded by Merrick, approved 6-0.
2. Probation – Bilingual Officer: This is a replacement for the Bilingual Probation Officer with a starting rate of \$23.25 unless they find someone with experience and then it could be hire this is a 70 hour a week position. Motion to approve was made by Mohr, seconded by O'Connor, approved 6-0.

### **TRANSFER JOB FROM FULL-TIME TO PART-TIME:**

Donna advised that the Drug Free Coalition lost their Federal Grant for 2026 so they will not have the money to fund a full-time position. Lori is willing to go down to part-time. The position will pay \$28.00 a hour and will work 21 hours a week. Motion to approve was made by O'Connor seconded by Merrick, approved 6-0.
