

The Shelby County Council met on Tuesday June 16, 2026, at 6:30 p.m., present were council members, Mohr, Merrick, Langkabel, Haacker, O'Connor, Barlow, Ruble, County Council Attorney, and the County Auditor (Zoom).

MINUTES:

Motion to approve Minutes from June 16, 2026, meeting was made by O'Connor, seconded by Mohr, approved 6-0-1 (Ruble).

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS:

The Commissioners are asking for an additional appropriation in fund 1135-33140-9703 (Bridge #22 Construction) in the amount of \$1,103,000.00. Motion to approve was made by Ruble, seconded by Mohr, approved 7-0.

Superior Court 1 is asking for an additional in fund 1211-31102-0000 (GAL State Funds) in the amount of \$2,279.00. Motion to approve was made by Mohr, seconded by Merrick, approved 7-0.

The Commissioners are asking for an additional appropriation in fund 4910-36100-0000 (RACINO – Maintenance Contracts) for the purchase of the ESRI software/maintenance in the amount of \$60,000.00. Motion to approve was made by Ruble, seconded by Mohr, approved 7-0.

The County Auditor is asking for an additional appropriation in fund 4403-41102-0000 (PV Bond) in the amount of \$581,793.76 for the bond payments. Motion to approve was made by Barlow, seconded by Ruble, approved 7-0.

MISCELLANEOUS:

CF-1 / SPEEDWAY SOLAR:

The County Auditor presented the Council with the Speedway Solar CF-1 compliance of abatement form. After some discussion about the property a Motion to vote this property was not in compliance for their abatement was made by Barlow, seconded by Ruble, approved 6-0.

The County Attorney advised they will work on getting a letter out to them and schedule the hearing for September 15, 2026.

PUBLIC SAFETY LIT/ FIRE DEPARTMENT DISTRIBUTION FOR 2027:

The County Auditor presented the letter from all 9 Fire Departments in the County requesting that the Public Safety money be split equally between all Fire Departments for 2027. Motion to accept all letters and their request was made by O'Connor, seconded by Langkabel, approved 7-0.

MHP INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT:

The Council was presented an Interlocal Agreement between MHP, City of Shelbyville and Shelby County. This agreement states that MHP will pay the City and County \$100,000.00 each for the next 3 years to help with ambulance cost. Motion to approve was made by O'Connor, seconded by Merrick, approved 7-0.

SOIL & WATER LETTER OF SUPPORT – SUGAR CREEK WATER SHED:

The Council was asked for an in-kind contribution from Council to the Soil & Water District for a Grant they have applied for, for the Sugar Creek Water Shed. Motion to approve \$7,000.00 in in-kind contributions was made by Barlow, seconded by Ruble, approved 7-0.

HUMAN RESOURCES:

Donna is requesting to post a replacement position for three departments:

1. Sheriff's Department – is requesting to replace their Records Clerk, this is a full-time position and hired in at a COMOT II. Starting pay will be \$21.85 per hour and will work 35 hours a week. Motion to approve was made by Barlow, seconded by O'Connor, approved 7-0.
2. Commissioner/Highway – is requesting to replace their Office Clerk, this is a full-time position and hired in at a COMOT II. Starting pay will be \$21.85 per hour and will work 35 hours a week. Motion to approve was made by Merrick, seconded by Mohr, approved 7-0.
3. Probation Department – is requesting to replace a Probation Officer, they will go by the Judicial Scale but will be a full-time position and work 35 hours per week. They are requesting that if someone from Community Corrections is hired they be brought in at the 3-year rate, otherwise if someone from the outside would be hired in off of the Judicial Scale based on years of being a probation officer. Motion to approve was made by Mohr, seconded by O'Connor, approved 7-0.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by O'Connor, seconded by Barlow, approved 7-0.
