Estimated cost of the facility was \$6.4 million and actual was \$6.7 million, estimated assessed value was \$2.8 M and actual assessed value was \$4.6 M. Mike with Premier advised they have closed their facilities in Johnson and Rush County and will be closing Bartholomew County in the future. Titus advised it that might be nice for some of the Council to go and take a tour of the facility, Mike agreed and told them to just contact the Manager Burk Admire and he would be happy to set that up.
