ORDINANCE NO. 2023-O

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECORDER'S OFFICE TO ESTABLISH A CASH CHANGE FUND

WHEREAS, Indiana Code section 36-1-8-2 provides that the fiscal body of a county may permit any of its officers or employees having a duty to collect cash revenues to establish a cash change fund;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code section 36-1-8-2 further provides that said fund must be established by a warrant drawn on the appropriate fund of the county in favor of the officer or employee, in an amount determined by the fiscal body;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code section 36-1-8-2 further provides that said warrant may be drawn without need for appropriation;

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Recorder (the "Recorder") is an officer of the county with a duty to collect cash revenues, including fees for the recording of documents;

WHERAS, the Recorder currently maintains cash on hand of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the purpose of making change when colleting cash revenues;

WHEREAS, the fees charged by the Recorder increased in 2017, which has increased the cash drawer needs of the Recorder;

WHEREAS, the funds for the Recorder's cash drawer derive from the County General Fund, subject to approval by the Shelby County Council (the "Council"); and

WHEREAS, the Recorder now desires to increase the amount of cash on hand to Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) to accommodate the Recorder's current cash drawer needs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF SHELBY COUNTY, INDIANA, as follows:

- 1. The Recorder is hereby authorized to establish a cash change fund.
- 2. The Recorder shall present, and the Auditor of Shelby County, Indiana, is authorized to pay, a warrant in the amount of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) out of the County General Fund.
 - 3. The Recorder shall use the cash to make change when collecting cash revenues.
- 4. If there is a change in the custodian of the fund, such as election of a new Recorder, or if it is determined that the fund is no longer needed, the entire cash change fund shall be returned to the County General Fund.
 - 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
- 6. This Ordinance is supplemental and in addition to any prior ordinances or resolutions and, to the extent any prior resolutions are inconsistent herewith, they are hereby modified.
